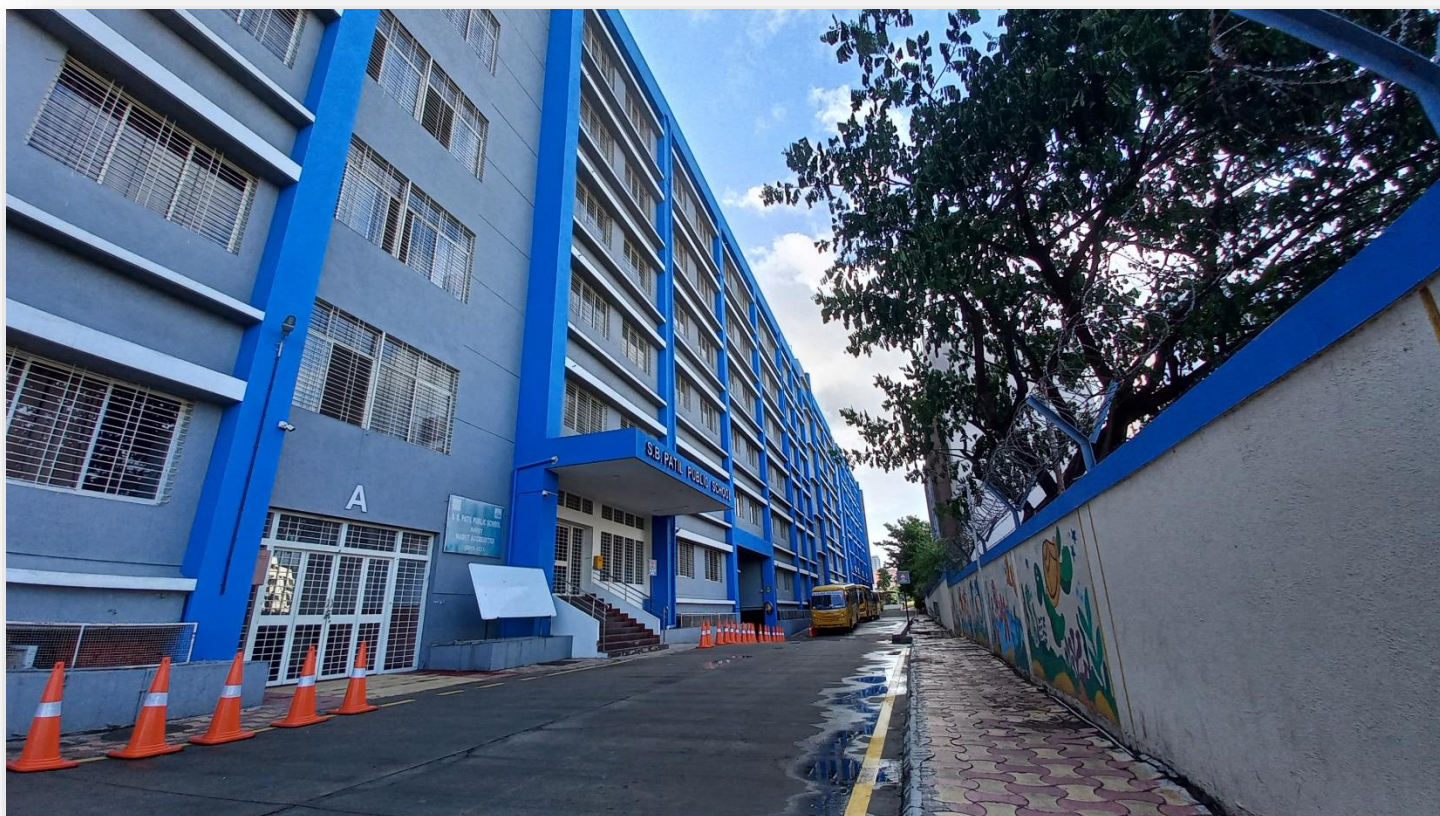

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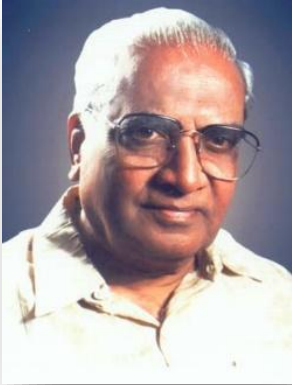

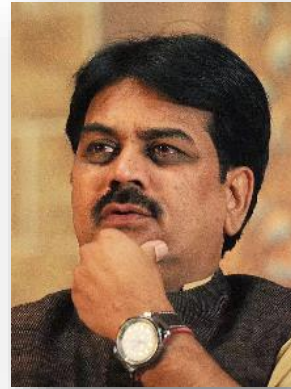

## INFRASTRUCTURE AND AMENITIES

### Classrooms and E-Learning

All classrooms are spacious, well-ventilated, aesthetically furnished and well-equipped with modern audio-visual facilities to enhance the teaching-learning process.



### Math Lab

The math lab is set up for students to learn mathematical concepts in the most enjoyable manner.



### Science Labs

Physics, chemistry and biology labs are well-equipped to help students put all they learn theoretically in class to practice.



### Social Science Lab

The school has a social science lab to help students understand the concepts of the social science subject in depth through hands-on activities.

## English Language Lab

An English Language lab equipped with Words Worth English Language software has been made available for students to enhance word pronunciation, expand vocabulary, improve writing proficiency, and boost overall linguistic competence.

## Elective Languages

The school provides three foreign language electives: French, German and Japanese, as well as the Indian languages of Sanskrit and Marathi from Grades VI to VIII. However, Marathi is introduced at the Grade I level and is taught till Grade X.

## Local, Regional, National and International Collaborations and Events

The school has collaborations with several institutes and organisations to propel the holistic development of students such as SPIC MACAY (Society for the Promotion of Indian Classical Music and Culture Amongst Youth) to empower the students with the fundamentals of singing and music, whilst also training our teachers to lead the teaching of music in our school.



In partnership with Torrins Music regular classes are held for students with emphasis on the learning of vocal and instrumental music. For the past two years, the school hosted the Regional and National RoboCup Junior Competition to encourage AI, STEM/ STEAM and Robotics amongst students.

The collaboration with British Council under the Recognition of an International Dimension in Schools (RIDS) programme will strengthen cross-cultural links, and weave international perspectives into learning, preparing students for a globalised future.

## Research Cell

A Research Cell comprising of students, parents, alumni and faculty exists so as to inculcate and promote the habit and practice of meticulous research for publications, reviews, paper presentations, seminars and other research-related activities.

## KHOJ

The need for research and continuous professional development is crucial as schools aim to provide inclusive and effective learning environments for an increasingly diverse student body. With this in mind, S.B. Patil Public School, has initiated KHOJ. This is a convention that provides a platform to faculty to present research papers, articles, etc. on advancing quality education through the UN's SDGs, and other changing paradigms in the field of education.

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## Computer and IT Labs

S.B. Patil Public School has multiple computer and IT labs, all of which are well-equipped with the latest and sophisticated hardware inclusive of computers for each individual student, printers, multimedia, Wi-Fi and uninterrupted internet connectivity.



## Robotics Labs

To nurture, teach and enhance the understanding and passion for Artificial Intelligence, coding and robotics amongst students at an early age, the school has robotics labs. Students are taught the essentials of robotics so that they develop a love for the subject.



## Innovation Lab

S.B. Patil Public School has an Innovation Lab to aid in helping students think, ideate, innovate, be creative whilst applying logic and analysis right from an early age to be successful entrepreneurs in future.



## ERP

The school is benefited with an ERP or Enterprise Resource Planner which manages the processes and communication of the school, and acts as a platform where teachers, the administration and management, and parents can interconnect regarding academic and administrative information.

## Eco-friendly Practices

S.B. Patil Public School has a dedicated gardening area and compost pit, a rainwater harvesting system, and solar panels so as to reduce consumption of supplied electricity. Not only do students partake in many eco-friendly activities and events such as river-cleaning, creating a bio-wall, and prevention of food wastage but even the faculty participate in many eco-oriented seminars. More so, we, as an institute, have also received many awards from the PCMC, GreenLine and the Times School Survey for being a green school.



## Association with Roots and Shoots

S.B. Patil Public School is proud to be associated with Roots and Shoots, a global network dedicated to empowering young people to take action on behalf of animals, people, and the environment. Through this collaboration, our students engage in meaningful projects that promote sustainability, environmental awareness, and social responsibility. By being part of the Roots and Shoots community, our school fosters a sense of compassion, leadership, and global citizenship among students, encouraging them to create positive changes in the world.



## Gifted Students' Programme

In association with the Kaveri Gifted Education Research Center (KGERC), the school has established a strategic partnership aimed at identifying and nurturing gifted students. Through this collaboration, a structured programme has been implemented to assess high-potential learners using research-backed methodologies, ensuring that their unique intellectual and creative abilities are recognised early. The initiative focuses on providing differentiated instruction, personalised learning plans, and appropriate enrichment opportunities to support their academic and emotional development, while also equipping teachers and parents with the tools needed to foster these students' exceptional capabilities.



## HOBBIES AND INTERESTS | CO AND EXTRA-CURRICULARS

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### Automated Library

The students and staff are free to access a completely automated school library - a compendium of currently over 13,500 books, encyclopedias, magazines, comics, newspapers, e-learning material, CDs and other multimedia - both educational and recreational. With the library being accessible to even parents, and new books added every few months, these resources aim to provide a wide range of printed and electronic resources to support the academic, creative and cultural development of all readers, especially students.



Students are expected to take proper care of the books issued and return the same during the designated period. The automation of the library has resulted in book lovers being able to borrow and return books without the need of manual entries by the librarians.

DEAR (Drop Everything And Read) Time is also given to students so that they can cultivate and invest in the habit of reading every day. Regular events such as book fairs along with various activities are held to promote and inculcate the habit of reading. 'Avid Reader' awards are conferred upon deserving students and faculty at the end of the academic year.

### Music and Dance

Students are provided the opportunity to explore avenues in music: singing, dancing, and playing musical instruments. In collaboration with Torrins Music, the school conducts regular classes for those interested in vocal and instrumental music. Those with a passion for the hobby can learn the keyboard, drums, guitar, tabla and vocals by the instructors at school. Professional dance instructors are part of the school's faculty and conduct dance classes for students



### Fine Art/ Creativity Room

A fine art/ creativity room has been allocated for students to engage| explore and realise their talents. Here, emphasis is given to appreciate art, culture and tradition along with a platform for students to develop their skills at drawing, painting and handicraft.



## **School Auditorium**

In the event of holding or hosting any manner of indoor function, celebration, programme, or co-/ extra-curricular activity, the school is equipped with a large, temperature-controlled auditorium. The stage, both literal and figurative, assists children to develop and enhance their public-speaking skills by helping them overcome stage fright and gain confidence in public oration.



## **Multi-purpose Hall**

The school is facilitated with a spacious multipurpose hall. Events such as exhibitions, sporting events, dance practices, the hosting of workshops, training seminars and other such activities are held here.



## **Sports and Recreation**

S.B. Patil Public School has a well-maintained in-campus playground. This benefits students to develop their athletic abilities whilst also having access to indoor games all of which cater to a wide age-group. Self-defense sports inclusive of karate are also taught to the children.

Regular educational trips and industrial visits are organised to help students of higher grades get practical exposure to the workings of the real-world. Annual excursions and picnics are organised so as to allow a day of ease for students.

## HEALTH, WELLBEING AND SAFETY

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### Canteen

Students and staff can avail clean, hygienically cooked, nutritious, well-balanced food in the safe, well-ventilated and welcoming environment of the school canteen. The menu is available on the school's website.



### Health Bay and First Aid Facilities

In the event of a medical exigency or first aid immediate medical services are available at the school itself with first-aid boxes on each floor and a health bay furnished with proper beds. Two experienced school nurses are present during school hours to attend to any health-related/ medical situation.



## Health Care and Medical Check-ups

The school has tie-ups with nearby hospitals so that in case of medical emergencies, appropriate aid can be provided at the earliest. In collaboration with these hospitals, the school organises annual health check-ups for students, faculty and support staff. All students' reports are made available on the school's ERP.

## Health Cards

Health cards of both students and staff are maintained that contain essential medical history and an allergy record.



## Mock Drills

Annual fire, earthquake, flood, external threat-safety and mock reverse drills are conducted in the school campus to ensure readiness and preparedness among students and staff in case of any exigency.

## CCTV Cameras

CCTV cameras are fitted throughout the school campus: at entry and exit points, in the school corridors, classrooms, labs, etc. These record and monitor all activity 24/7.



## Fire Extinguishers and Hoses

The school is equipped with fire extinguishers and water hoses on every floor as a proactive safety measure. These are strategically installed to ensure a quick response in case of fire emergencies. Regular maintenance and staff training are conducted to ensure operational readiness and awareness. Additionally, teams from the fire department and related emergency services regularly visit the school to provide hands-on training, demonstrations, and vital information to staff and students. The safety and well-being of all students and staff remain a top priority.

## Emergency and Help Line Contacts

Emergency contact numbers of the nearest hospital, police, fire departments, as well as contacts of child welfare, women's welfare, cyber safety organisations etc. are displayed at strategic locations on every floor of the school so as to provide ease of access to calling services in case of any emergency.

## Committees

The school also has a POCSSO, POSH, Sakhi Savitri, Students' Redressal Cell, Transport, and an Anti-bullying and Anti-Ragging Committee to preside over and manage any situation that may arise. Other initiatives also include the Adolescent Peer Educators Leadership programmes in Life Skills, and the Health and Wellness Programme by the CBSE and State Education Department. Students are active members within these committees and programmes.

## Policies

The school has several policies instated to ensure the overall well-being and security of students. Such include Alcohol and Substance Abuse Prevention, Child Rights, Child Welfare, Cyber Safety, Financial Charity, Gender Sensitisation, ICT, Inclusion and Inclusive Practices, Social Awareness and Sensitisation, Student Freedom within Academia and CCA, etc.

## School Counsellors and Wellness Coach

S.B. Patil Public School has appointed professional and proficient counsellors and a wellness coach to listen to, advice and guide students, parents and teachers during times of need.

## Special Educator

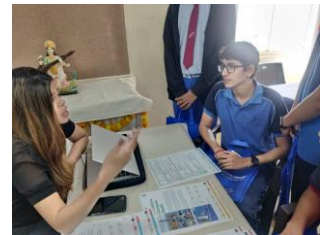

## Documents to be submitted after confirmation of Admission

### For Grade I

Original Birth Certificate (laminated) to be submitted in the school office within a month from the date of admission.

### For Grade II onwards

Original Birth Certificate/ School Leaving Certificate received from the previous school to be submitted in the school office within a month from the date of admission.

**NOTE:** Admission of a student will be considered provisional until the submission of his/her Birth Certificate or an appropriate School Leaving Certificate/ Transfer Certificate in the school office. School reserves the right of cancellation of admission in case of non-availability of said documents.

### Admission for Grade XI

1. Admission will be on the basis of the student's performance in Grade X, as well as on the aptitude of the student.
2. For students who have completed their Grade X from other schools and boards (besides CBSE), the discretion for admission rests with the principal, subject to availability of seats in various streams.
3. Detailed information regarding admission for all grades shall be available on the school's website.

## **RTE Admissions**

25% seats are reserved in Grade 1 under RTE act and as per the guidelines from the State Education Department.

### **Admission Process under RTE:**

1. Parents need to fill in the online form on the RTE website.
2. Once the school is allotted, verification will be done by government officials.
3. After verification, the parent approaches the school for completing the admission process.
4. No Tuition fee is applicable for students studying under the RTE Act. Additional Fees for Robotics, uniform, books, picnics, annual functions, transport, canteen services, external examinations, as well as miscellaneous charges for the school diary, students and parents' ID cards, planner, ERP, HPC, class photograph, school magazine and other publications will be paid by all students - General and those under the RTE Act. Please note that picnics, external examinations, transport and canteen services are optional facilities.
5. No interview or test is administered as per the RTE admission guidelines.

### **General Guidelines**

1. Admission shall be granted in an age-appropriate way purely on the basis of availability of seats. The school reserves the right to grant admission to the deserving students.
2. Age criteria for admission to various grades shall be as prescribed by the State Education Department.
3. 25% seats are reserved for admissions in Grade I under the RTE Act as per the State Education Department guidelines.
4. For mid-term admissions, fees for the entire academic year needs to be paid.
5. Admission for all other classes i.e. from Grade II onwards shall be treated as provisional admission until the receipt of original Leaving Certificate/ Transfer Certificate (laminated) from the previous school attended.
6. Students transferring from another state must submit the school leaving certificate countersigned by the Education Officer of that state.
7. School fee(s) once paid shall be non-refundable and non-transferable.

## **ASSESSMENTS AND PROMOTION**

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Assessments and promotions shall be according to the CBSE norms. More emphasis shall be given to Competency Based Assessments.
