
As per the recommendations of the National Education Policy 2020, the Government of India launched a centrally sponsored scheme called New India Literacy Program, popularly known as ULLAS (Understanding of Lifelong Learning for All in Society) for a period of five years, starting in 2022 until 2027.

Under ULLAS, the mission of the programme: The Nav Bharat Saksharta Karyakram is to provide an opportunity to attain foundational literacy

and numeracy, and critical life skills. This paves a way for the learner to perform varied tasks in daily life ranging from carrying out basic financial transactions, comprehending one's rights, communicating both verbally and in written, etc.

The primary objective of the scheme is to empower all people aged 15 years and above who have not had the opportunity to educate themselves, and to enable them to contribute to the growth of the country.

The scheme is implemented through volunteerism. Learners are encouraged to access the content in local languages in online mode through DIKSHA platform in NCERT. Government-aided schools



registered under UDISE are the units of implementation of the scheme which are run by the State/UT Governments.
