A session on Sensory Processing Disorder

On 19th March 2024, a session on Sensory Processing Disorder was conducted by Dr. Sayali Havele from 10.00.a.m to 12.00 pm. A total of 32 teachers from pre-primary, and Grade I and II attended the session in the auditorium.
