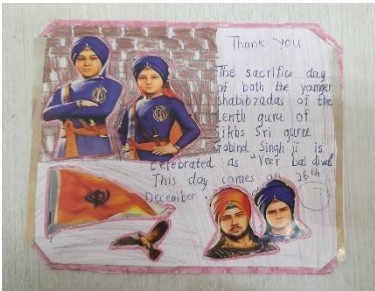
## Commemorating Veer Baal Diwas
