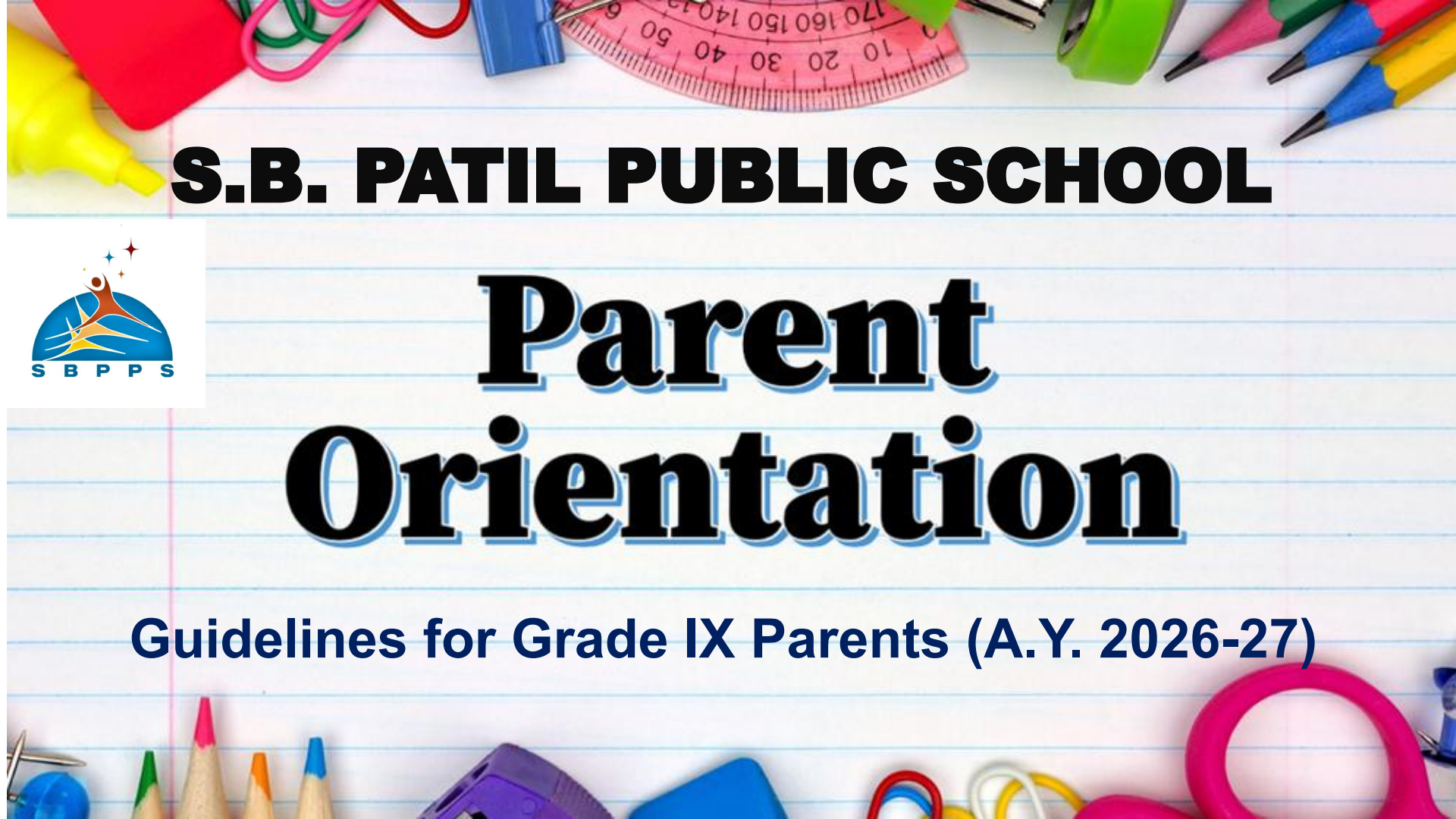

- Parent – Teacher Meeting Timings: Parents can meet teachers on 2nd and 4th Saturday of every month with a prior appointment.

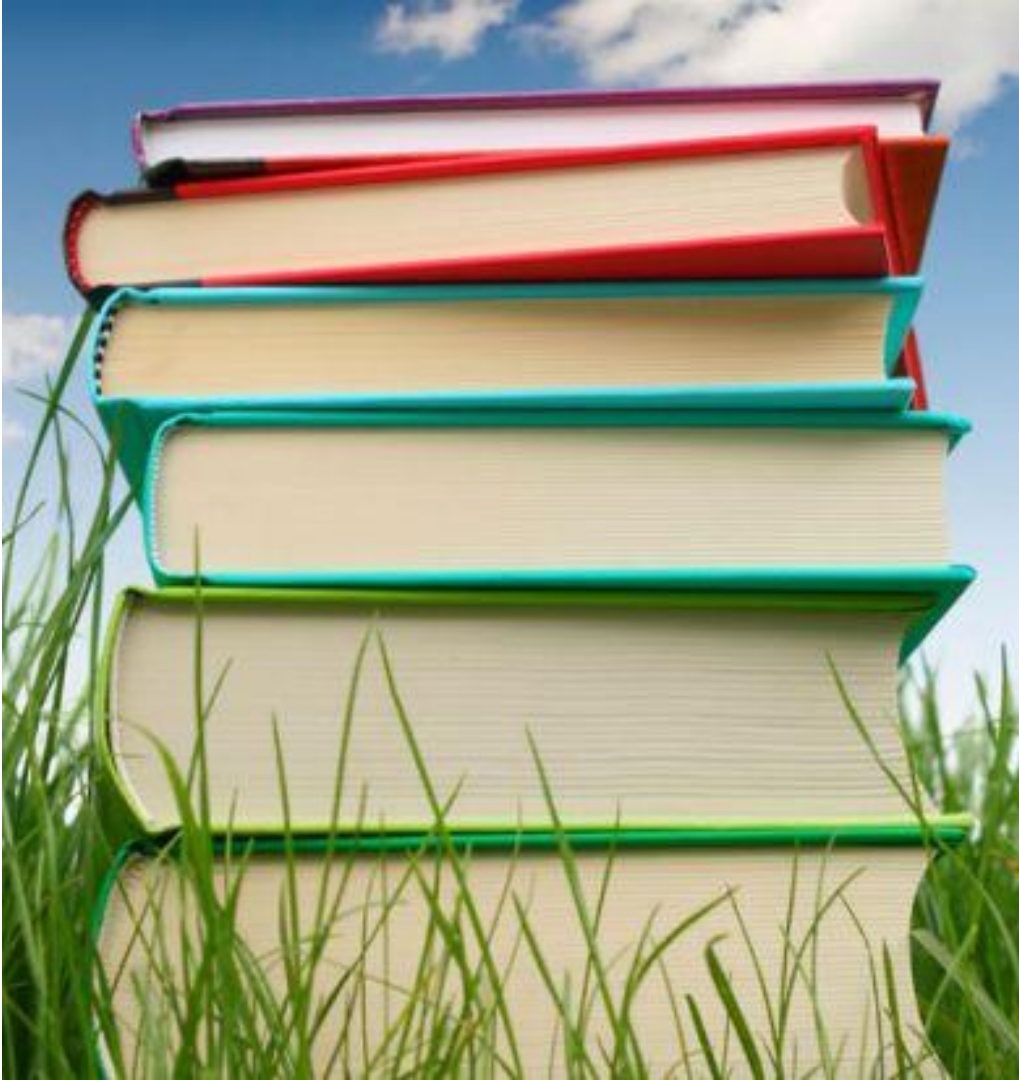
Parents who come to pick & drop their wards should not insist on meeting teachers at random hours.

GENERAL DISCIPLINE

- Students are expected to maintain a high standard in their general behaviour and manner of speech.
- Students should greet the teachers and other staff members, whenever they meet them.

- 75% attendance is compulsory for promotion to the next grade and it shall be followed across all levels and grades. Attendance is mandatory on the re-opening day and the last working day of the term.
- Absence from school for mere social functions is highly discouraged.
- In case a child shall remain/ has been absent from school, parents are expected to send a proper note with reason in the school diary.

GENERAL DISCIPLINE

- In case any student reports late to the school for 3 days, then during the 4th late coming, the said student shall be sent back home and parents need to come to school to fetch their ward.
- Care must be taken of all school property. Students must not scribble and write on books, desks, walls or any school property and/or carve names on the benches. All damages must be reported to the Grade teacher/principal. In case of damage to school property, a fine will be charged and the cost of repairs will be borne and recovered from the pupil.
- Any kind of jewellery and other valuable ornaments are not allowed in the school. Students need to refrain from wearing dangling earrings, fancy chains, anklets and applying nail paints.
- Girls need to have two plaits/ ponytails depending on the hair length. Wearing of fancy hairpins, hair bands, *gajras* and flowers in the hair is strictly forbidden. For boys, fancy, stylish haircuts are not permitted under any circumstance.

GENERAL DISCIPLINE

- On birthdays, no gifts and sweets are to be distributed among students and staff. However, students can donate a book to the library or a sapling as a gesture of goodwill and celebration.
- The internet and the various applications are a lot of fun and a wonderful tool.....maximize the benefits and reduce the risks.
- The misusing of social media platforms like Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, etc., to harm the school's reputation or cause distress to classmates will result in strict disciplinary action.
- Using the school's name online or creating a school-related page without authorisation is prohibited.
- Proper school uniform needs to be worn by the students at all times. In case of non- availability of uniform parents need to send a note in the school diary.
- Parents need to attend all Online/Offline PTMs and Open Houses to avoid any last minute difficulties and the anxiety.
- Students are not permitted to ride the geared scooters/ bikes and which need a proper driving license. However, bicycles can be used for the commuting purpose.

GENERAL DISCIPLINE

- Students are strictly prohibited from bringing mobile phones and other electronic gadgets to school. If found these shall be confiscated.
- Use the school ERP for all kind of communication. Change the password regularly to avoid any kind of misuse/threat.
- Lending or borrowing of money or other articles is not allowed.
- No class parties with regards to celebrations for students and staff can be held in the school premises.
- Students using the school bus will maintain proper discipline in the bus.
- Parents and guardians may meet the teachers during the specified time/ or as per the appointment. Whenever you receive a call/message to meet school staff, you are expected to respond/meet the staff.
- For all kind of services- Transport, Canteen etc. you are requested to contact the school Admin Manager in the admin bay.

STUDENT SAFETY AND SECURITY

- We endorse inclusivity in the school campus, hence commenting on any student/ faculty/ parent/ stakeholder's caste, religion, gender, name, disability, appearance/ looks, or any personal aspect is strictly prohibited.
- Various committees have been established - POCSO, Sakhi Savitri, Student Redressal Cell, etc as per the State Govt. GR.
- Avoid traffic congestion outside school and nearby construction sites.
- Practice vehicle pooling
- Wear helmets: for both pillion riders, and for students commuting by cycle.
- The school and career counselor shall be available for all kind of personal and career guidance.
- We do not encourage private autos and vans for transporting our students.
- Safety barriers will be installed inside the campus to ensure legitimate entry of visitors.
- Takrar petis (in all ladies' washrooms on all floors) and I Think, I Feel Box (in the Health Bay) have been installed for students and faculty to share their ideas and observations.

- Have positive and encouraging conversations with them, and avoid unnecessary criticism and comparing.
- You need to work with your child's teacher to achieve a common goal for the betterment of the child.
- Always work it out with the teacher before you reprimand your child of not putting in enough effort. Trust your child and give optimum opportunities to make mistakes.
- Avoid arguments with teachers and staff.
- Be kind to your children, but....be kind wisely.
