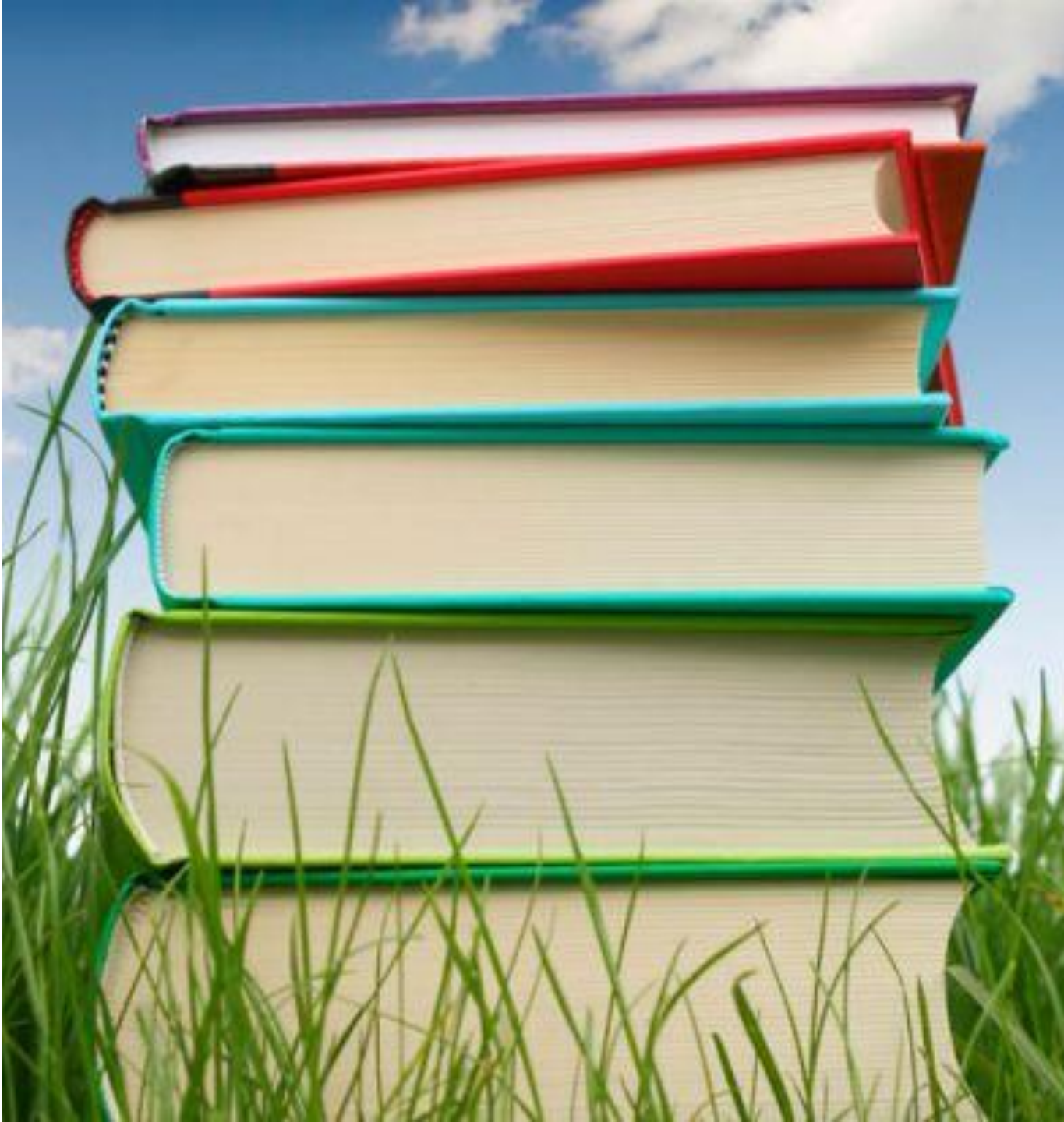
- Annual Planner can be viewed on the school ERP under Communication tab. You can refer to the same for evaluations, celebrations, events, competitions, holidays etc.

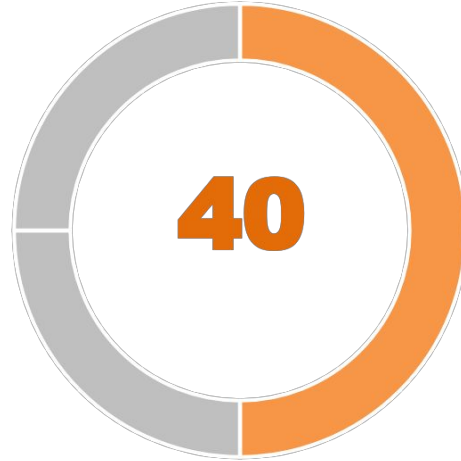

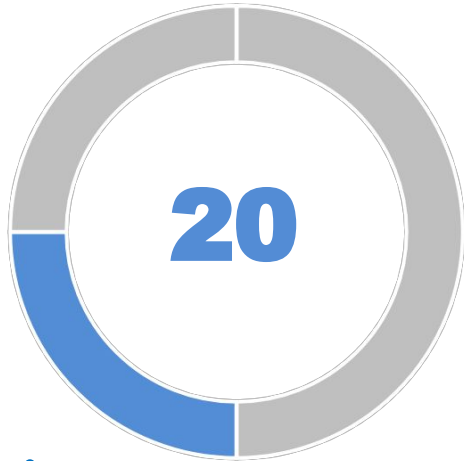
- The curriculum provided by CBSE is based on the National Education Policy 2020 and seeks to provide opportunities for students to achieve expected learning outcomes.

GENERAL DISCIPLINE

- Students are expected to maintain a high standard in their general behaviour and manner of speech.
- Students should greet the teachers and other staff members, whenever they meet them.
- All students should take honest pride in keeping the school premise clean. Litter should be put into the bins provided for the purpose.
- Eating on the stairs and/ or in the corridors is not permitted.
- Carry school diary daily.
- Bring textbooks and notebooks as per the timetable to avoid heavy bags.

- Medium of instruction and conversation should be English, except the language periods.
- Marathi language is taught from Grade I onwards.

GENERAL DISCIPLINE

- Attentiveness and regularity in Grade assignments & homework needs to be given due importance. In case any evaluation is missed out, no student shall be permitted to reappear for the same.
- A retest will be permitted after providing proper supporting documents if there is absence for written evaluations due to any medical reason,
- 75% attendance is compulsory for promotion to the next grade and it shall be followed across all levels and grades. Attendance is mandatory on the re-opening day and the last working day of the term.
- Absence from school for mere social functions is highly discouraged.
- In case a child shall remain/ has been absent from school, parents are expected to send a proper note with reason in the school diary.

GENERAL DISCIPLINE

- In case any student reports late to the school for 3 days, then during the 4th late coming, the said student shall be sent back home and parents need to come to school to fetch their ward.
- Care must be taken of all school property. Students must not scribble and write on books, desks, walls or any school property and/or carve names on the benches. All damages must be reported to the Grade teacher/principal. In case of damage to school property, a fine will be charged and the cost of repairs will be borne and recovered from the pupil.
- Any kind of jewellery and other valuable ornaments are not allowed in the school. Students need to refrain from wearing dangling earrings, fancy chains, anklets and applying nail paints.
- For girls wearing of fancy hairpins, hair bands, *gajras* and flowers is not permitted.
- For boys, fancy, stylish haircuts are not allowed under any circumstances.
