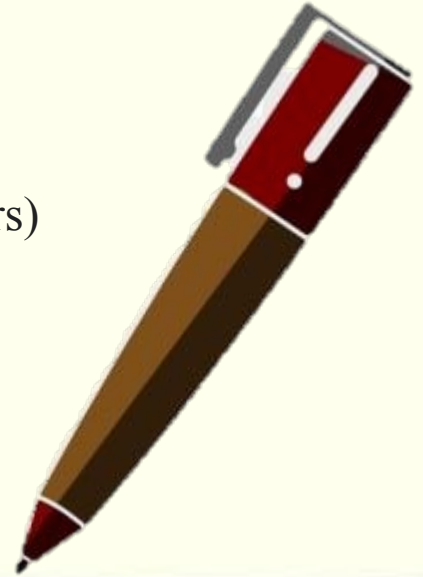

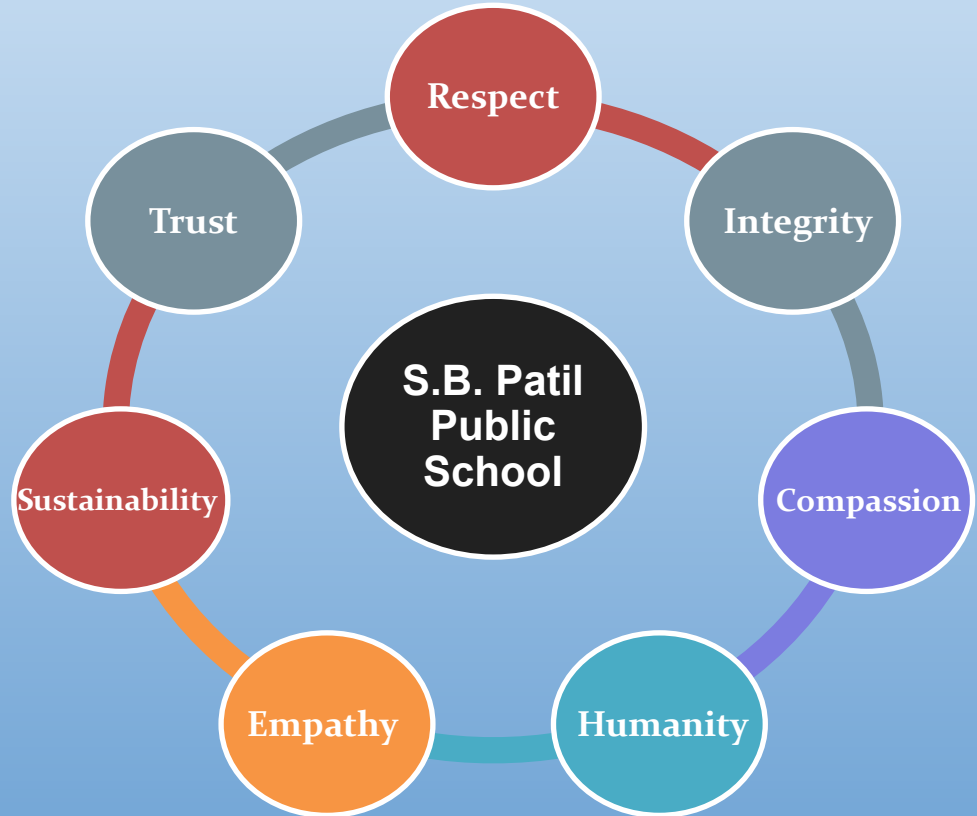

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Kindly send the books, notebooks, crayon box, clay box labelled with child's name, Class/Division on the first day (13th April).
- All other belongings of the child should also be labeled like Pencil box, Tiffin box/bag, Water bottle, School bag etc.
- To reduce bag weight, teachers keep the books & notebooks in the school. Only few books will be carried by the child every day.
- Details of books & notebooks to be retained in the school shall be shared timely.

GENERAL DISCIPLINE

- Children those who are not coming by school bus, must report 5 minutes before their school timings.
- Do not send any valuable items or gold ornaments with your child. In case of any loss, school shall not be responsible.
- **Kindly note:** Do not make your child wear bangles, bindis/kumkum or any kind of ornaments. No mehndi and nail polish is to be applied. Clip child's nails regularly. Girls with long hair should tie two ponytails with black rubber band and wear black cloth hair band only. Girls with short hair should wear black cloth hair band only. No fancy or plastic hair band to be used. Boys will maintain short hair and no fancy hair cuts will be allowed.

GENERAL DISCIPLINE

- Walk-in students shall not be released/handed over to anyone other than his/her own parents.
- Students must bring their school diary daily.
- Regularity in assignments & homework needs to be given due importance.
- In case any assessment is missed out, it shall not be re conducted.
- It is compulsory for students to wear the school identity card daily, in case of damage/loss parents needs to send a request for issuing a new ID card to the admin department .
- 75% attendance is compulsory for promotion to the next grade and it shall be followed across all levels and grades.

GENERAL DISCIPLINE

- Attendance is mandatory on the re-opening day and the last working day of the term.
- Absence from school for mere social functions is highly discouraged.
- In case a child shall remain/ has been absent from school, parents are expected to send a proper note with reason in the school diary.
- School Counselor and special educator shall be available for all kind of support / guidance.
- Proper school Uniform needs to be worn by the students at all times. In case of non- availability of uniform parents need to send a note in the school diary.

GENERAL DISCIPLINE

- On birthdays, no gifts are to be distributed among students and staff, and the distribution of sweets must also be avoided. However, students can donate a book to the library or a sapling as a gesture of goodwill and celebration.
- Parents need to attend all PTMs and Open Houses to avoid any last minute difficulties and the anxiety.
- Parents are kindly requested to respond to phone calls from the school.
- Use the school ERP/ school diary for all kind of communication. Change the password regularly to avoid any kind of misuse/ threat. Upload Aadhar Card image and photo of the child for ID card and other requirements as stated by the State Education Department.

GENERAL DISCIPLINE

- For all kind of services- Transport, Canteen etc. you are requested to contact the school Admin Manager/ Admin Assistant in the admin office.
- Parents should check the books, homework and students' diary every day. Diary should be signed regularly by the parent(s). Kindly go through every page of the diary.
- All parents are required to abide by the school rules and guidelines shared from time to time.
- In case any student reports late to the school for 3 days, then during the 4th late coming, the said student shall be sent back home and parents need to come to school to fetch their ward.

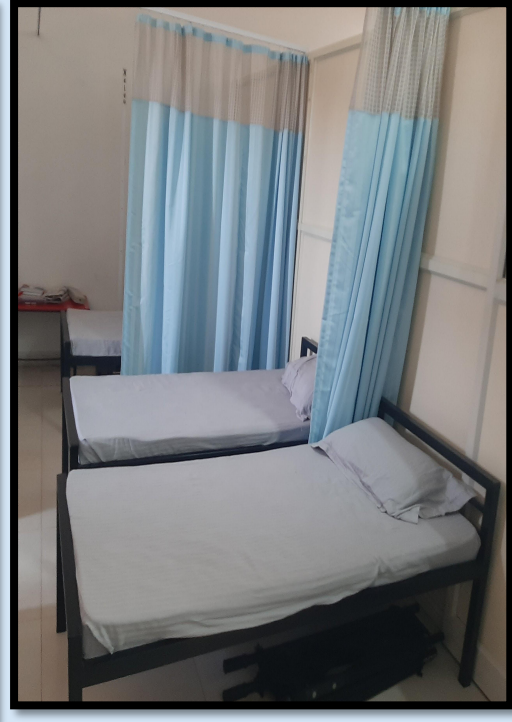

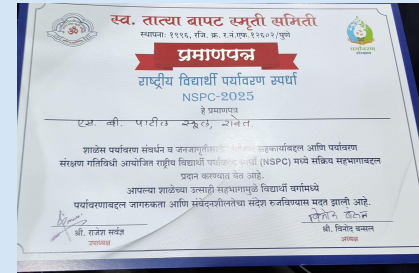

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: What will my child learn in Senior KG?

- Reading simple words, phonics sounds
- Writing letters and small words (English and Hindi)
- Numbers, counting, basic addition & subtraction

Q: My child cannot read/write yet. Is that okay?

- Yes, Learning starts in Senior KG, step by step
- Every child learns at their own pace

Q: What is the daily routine in class?

- Circle time, story & rhymes, phonics, activities, play time - Balanced learning + fun

- Activity-based learning

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- Give time and encouragement. We support confidence building in class.

Q: How much homework will be given?

- Very little, simple, meaningful and practice-based
- Focus is more on understanding than causing pressure

Q: How can we help at home?

- Reading daily, Practice writing and counting, Talk and interact more

Q: My child is very active / not sitting in one place, is it normal?

- It is normal for this age. We use activities to engage them.

- Yes, but limited screen time (20-30 mins) only should be permitted
