Swachh Bharat Diwas (SBD) is being observed on 2nd October 2024 as a tribute to the Father of Nation. As a prelude to SBD 2024, the annual Swachhata Hi Seva (SHS) fortnight is being jointly organised by Department of Drinking Water and Sanitation, Ministry of Jal Shakti; and Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs w.e.f. 14th September to 2nd October, 2024.
