

From Students to Leaders: The Investiture Ceremony (2026-27)

On Thursday, 30th July, 2026, S.B. Patil Public School hosted its prestigious Investiture Ceremony for the academic year 2026–27, held with great dignity and enthusiasm in the school auditorium. The tilak and badge presentation ceremony followed, during which each elected council member was ceremonially honoured with a badge of office and a traditional tilak by the school leadership and House Teachers.
