Constitution Day or “Samvidhan Divas” is observed annually on 26th November to mark the adoption of the Constitution of India. On this day in 1949, the Constituent Assembly of India adopted the Constitution, which came into force on 26th January, 1950. And so, to honour Dr. B.R.
