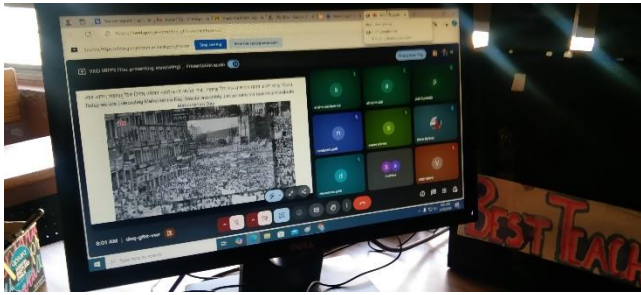


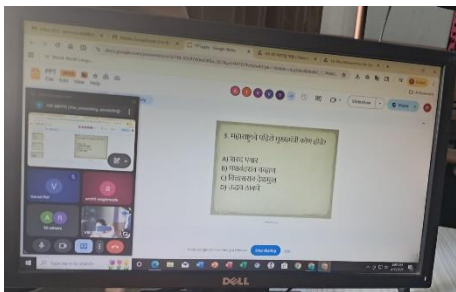
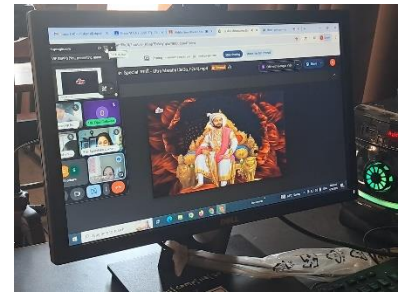
# Where Forts Echo and Pride Endures: A Maharashtra Day Special Assembly 2026
