S.B. Patil Public School observed Constitution Day with a series of engaging and meaningful activities held across the campus on Wednesday, 26th November, 2025. The celebrations brought together students, teachers, and staff to honour the guiding principles of the Indian Constitution and to reaffirm its relevance in everyday civic life.

The day commenced with a mass reading of the Preamble, described as the heart of the Constitution. Principal Dr. Bindu Saini; vice principal, Ms. Padmavati Banda; headmaster, Mrs. Shubhangi Kulkarni; administrative manager, Mr. Manish Dhekale; and section coordinators Ms. Supreya Nitin, Ms. Nayna Taru, Ms. Archana Prabhune, and Ms. Vandana Sangle. joined members of the administrative staff in leading the collective recitation. For the older students, faculty member Ms. Manjusha Nathe conducted the *Uddeshika Lekhan* activity, wherein learners wrote the Preamble in Marathi using elegant calligraphy in the Devanagari script. The activity encouraged artistic expression while deepening appreciation for the Constitution's language and spirit. Students demonstrated keen interest and creativity throughout.

As per CBSE directives, a campus-wide reading of the Preamble was held at 11.00 a.m. CBSE activities incharge, Ms. Swaleha Mujawar, addressed the gathering with a brief annotation on the heritage, greatness, and enduring significance of the Indian Constitution, and led in its recitation.
