S.B. Patil Public School, Pune, successfully conducted the British Council RIDS 2025–26 collaborative exchange on SDG 15: Life on Land on 14th November, 2025. The session brought together students, educators, and international partners to explore the rich biodiversity of India, South Korea, and Dubai under the theme Unravelling the Magic on Land — Flora and Fauna.

The school was joined by Mr. Uri Fah from Indonesia, who delivered an insightful presentation on Agritech in Education with a focus on butterfly conservation. His session introduced students to innovative practices that merge technology with environmental stewardship, emphasising the significance of protecting delicate ecosystems.



Students from Grades IV and V took an active part in the exchange, presenting their scrapbook projects on SDG 15 and engaging enthusiastically with the theme of butterfly conservation. The activity formed part of the broader E2 Educator Exchange Microsoft Programme, enabling young learners to connect global perspectives with local action.



The collaboration will continue in December with another online exchange centred on SDG 15, further strengthening cross-country learning and dialogue.
