

Commencing the Academic Year of 2025-26: The Parent Orientation Programmes

As the new academic year 2025-26 unfolded, S.B. Patil Public School hosted a comprehensive parents' orientation program, aimed at fostering a strong partnership between the school and families. The sessions, held across multiple grades from Nursery to Grade XII, provided an insightful overview of the school's vision, curriculum, and expectations for the year ahead.
