## It's Movie Time!:

### The Screenings of *Chalo Jeete Hain* and *The Silent Hero*

From 14<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> October, our school organised special movie screenings for students from Grade I to V, featuring two inspiring films — *Chalo Jeete Hain* and *The Silent Hero*.

*Chalo Jeete Hain* is based on the childhood of Prime Minister Narendra Modi and is widely shown in schools, including those affiliated with CBSE. As directed by the Ministry of Education, schools were encouraged to screen this film between 16<sup>th</sup> September and 2<sup>nd</sup> October, 2025 to promote core values such as character, service, and responsibility.
